In WA, the tropical cyclone season occurs between November and April each year, however the Bureau of Meteorology has officially declared that El Niño and a positive Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD) are underway. Warmer and drier conditions have already been forecast for spring and summer and El Niño events increase the risk of extreme temperature shifts, like hotter days and heatwaves. Both El Niño and a positive IOD tend to draw rain away from Australia, increasing the risk of bush fires so it is wise to prepare for any potential emergency now. Designated Area Migration Agreement Update



DAMA is a formal agreement between the Australian Government and a regional, state or territory authority. It provides access to more overseas workers than the standard skilled migration programs allow. It currently exists in Pilbara, Goldfields Esperance & South West.

For those that attended the first meeting in May, the DAMA for Gascoyne & Midwest has prepared a 'Request for Pricing (RFP)' to develop the business case for the region and subsequently present to the Department of Home Affairs for DAMA approval.
